The five-year projection for the population in the area is 134,037 representing a change of 1.23% annually from 2020 to 2025. Currently, the population is 48.5% male and 51.5% female.

The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 47.3 in the identified area, compared to 65.1 for the U.S. as a whole.

The number of families in the current year is 33,048 in the specified area.

Current median household income is \$79,656 in the area, compared to \$62,203 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$84,483 in five years, compared to \$67,325 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$111,643 in this area, compared to \$90,054 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$123,949 in five years, compared to \$99,510 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$42,726 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$34,136. The per capita income is projected to be \$47,260 in five years, compared to \$37,691 for all U.S. households

Currently, 66.1% of the 50,232 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 29.6%, renter occupied; and 4.4% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 44,347 housing units in the area - 66.9% owner occupied, 27.9% renter occupied, and 5.2% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 5.69%. Median home value in the area is \$245,464, compared to a median home value of \$235,127 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.14% annually to \$286,451.

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
