Currently, 37.4% of the 184,832 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 52.1%, renter occupied; and 10.5% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 168,550 housing units in the area - 42.0% owner occupied, 47.2% renter occupied, and 10.8% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 4.18%. Median home value in the area is \$277,456, compared to a median home value of \$235,127 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.63% annually to \$315,870.
