Current median household income is \$53,285 in the area, compared to \$62,203 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$55,668 in five years, compared to \$67,325 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$69,202 in this area, compared to \$90,054 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$75,723 in five years, compared to \$99,510 for all U.S. households

Currently, 56.2% of the 67,088 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 37.1%, renter occupied; and 6.7% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 63,214 housing units in the area - 59.9% owner occupied, 32.6% renter occupied, and 7.5% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.68%. Median home value in the area is \$136,234, compared to a median home value of \$235,127 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.90% annually to \$157,156.

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
