Current average household income is \$70,216 in this area, compared to \$90,054 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$74,985 in five years, compared to \$99,510 for all U.S. households

Currently, 44.8% of the 108,415 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 42.1%, renter occupied; and 13.1% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 101,999 housing units in the area - 46.4% owner occupied, 40.8% renter occupied, and 12.9% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.75%. Median home value in the area is \$141,612, compared to a median home value of \$235,127 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.32% annually to \$158,800.
