Current average household income is \$132,367 in this area, compared to \$90,054 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$143,775 in five years, compared to \$99,510 for all U.S. households

Currently, 62.5% of the 128,294 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.0%, renter occupied; and 4.4% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 103,656 housing units in the area - 67.0% owner occupied, 28.8% renter occupied, and 4.2% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 9.94%. Median home value in the area is \$330,172, compared to a median home value of \$235,127 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 0.88% annually to \$345,041.
