The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 81.1 in the identified area, compared to 65.1 for the U.S. as a whole.

Currently, 42.6% of the 156,478 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 49.1%, renter occupied; and 8.3% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 135,288 housing units in the area - 49.3% owner occupied, 42.7% renter occupied, and 8.0% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 6.68%. Median home value in the area is \$251,007, compared to a median home value of \$235,127 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.02% annually to \$277,439.
