The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 60.9 in the identified area, compared to 65.1 for the U.S. as a whole.

Current median household income is \$83,865 in the area, compared to \$62,203 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$87,841 in five years, compared to \$67,325 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$120,276 in this area, compared to \$90,054 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$130,177 in five years, compared to \$99,510 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$46,810 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$34,136. The per capita income is projected to be \$50,480 in five years, compared to \$37,691 for all U.S. households

Currently, 59.0% of the 102,503 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 37.2%, renter occupied; and 3.7% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 93,371 housing units in the area - 59.9% owner occupied, 34.2% renter occupied, and 5.9% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 4.23%. Median home value in the area is \$287,188, compared to a median home value of \$235,127 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.54% annually to \$310,020.

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
